

# CAT AND DOG HOUSE LOCATION AND REQUIREMENTS



When finding the **RIGHT SPOT** for the doghouse or cat house, **PLEASE** consider the following:

**The Doghouse or Cat house Should Be:**

1. Up against the humans' home, not out in the middle of nowhere.
2. Made of wood or other similar materials.
3. Set up off the ground a few inches.
4. Away from the direct wind
5. In a shady spot in the summer.
6. Insulated and filled with a type of bedding (i.e. straw)
7. Equipped with a door flap to keep out wind and snow in the winter.

**Make Sure:**

1. The dog and cat has fresh water in a tip proof, non metal dish, and that the water does not freeze in the winter. Make sure that your dog and cat has water at all times.
2. That they are fed properly.
3. That they are kept in good health.
4. The chain or rope used to restrain them cannot get tangled around objects or trees and bushes, and that it is at least 20 feet long.
5. The dog or cat is only left out for 20 minutes without shelter (weather permitting).
6. All outside Kennels (runs) must be at least 10 ft X 10 ft with a dog house attached to the outside to give the dog room for exercise.
7. At -20 degrees with the wind chill, all cats and dogs must be taken inside.
